

DC LAMBDA SQUARES WARREN JAQUITH SCHOLARSHIP FUND

THE WARREN JAQUITH SCHOLARSHIP FUND IS BEING ESTABLISHED WITHIN DC LAMBDA SQUARES TO HONOR THE LASTING CONTRIBUTIONS MADE BY WARREN JAQUITH, A FOUNDING MEMBER, LONGTIME CALLER, AVID SUPPORTER AND DEAR FRIEND OF OUR CLUB.

IT IS THE INTENTION OF THE BOARD IN ESTABLISHING THIS SCHOLARSHIP FUND, THAT OTHER ENDOWMENTS WILL BE DONATED OR RAISED TO ENHANCE THE FUND. SUCH FUNDS WILL BE MAINTAINED IN A SEPARATE DCLS ACCOUNT.

SCHOLARSHIPS FROM THE FUND MAY BE AWARDED TO FUND THE RECIPIENTS' REGISTRATION FEE FOR ONE OF THE FUNCTIONS LISTED BELOW:

- 1. THE DC LAMBDA SQUARES' ANNUAL FLY-INS**
- 2. THE CHESAPEAKE SQUARES' ANNUAL FLY-IN**
- 3. CALLER SCHOOLS (AS DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE BOARD)**
- 4. THE IAGSDC'S ANNUAL CONVENTION**
- 5. SQUARE DANCE CLASSES**
- OR**
- 6. THE WISHES OF THE APPLICANT**

THE DCLS PRESIDENT SHALL APPOINT AN AD HOC COMMITTEE TO REVIEW APPLICATIONS AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE BOARD. THE MAKE-UP OF THE AD HOC COMMITTEE SHALL INCLUDE THE DCLS TREASURER, ONE OTHER DCLS BOARD MEMBER AND AT LEAST ONE DCLS CLUB MEMBER WHO IS NOT A MEMBER OF THE BOARD. APPLICANTS FOR FUNDS SHOULD SUBMIT A LETTER OUTLINING THE PURPOSED USE OF THE FUNDS AND THE REASON THE SCHOLARSHIP IS NEEDED. REQUESTS FOR FUNDING SHOULD BE FORWARDED TO THE TREASURER AT LEAST TWO MONTHS IN ADVANCED OF THE FUNCTION TO ALLOW ADEQUATE TIME TO REVIEW AND CONSIDER THE REQUEST.

IT IS THE INTENT OF THE BOARD THAT SCHOLARSHIPS SHOULD BE USED PRIMARILY FOR REGISTRATIONS TO THE FUNCTIONS LISTED ABOVE AND

NOT FOR TRAVEL OR ACCOMMODATIONS; HOWEVER EXCEPTIONS MAY BE MADE AT THE DISCRETION OF THE BOARD, BASED UPON A RECOMMENDATION OF THE AD HOC COMMITTEE.

WHEN A REQUEST FOR FUNDS HAS BEEN APPROVED, THE BOARD WILL ARRANGE TO EITHER REGISTER THE RECIPIENT AT THE REQUESTED FUNCTION OR PROVIDE THE FUNDING DIRECTLY TO THE APPLICANT. IN THE LATTER CASE, THE BOARD SHALL REQUEST THAT THE RECIPIENT PROVIDE DOCUMENTATION OF THE USE OF THE FUNDS.

THE RECIPIENT(S) NAME WILL NOT BE DISCLOSED TO THE GENERAL MEMBERSHIP WITHOUT PRIOR PERMISSION.

IT IS THE INTENT OF THE BOARD THAT THIS BE A CONTINUING, ONGOING FUND AND THAT IT BE PERIODICALLY REPLENISHED. IF THE FUND DROPS BELOW \$100 AND IS NOT REPLENISHED, THE BOARD MAY ELECT TO DISSOLVE THE FUND AND DISPERSE THE REMAINING BALANCE.

THIS DOCUMENT, WHEN RATIFIED BY THE DCLS BOARD, BECOMES THE INITIAL DOCUMENT IN THE WARREN JAQUITH SCHOLARSHIP FUND ARCHIVE. THE SECRETARY IN A SEPARATE FOLDER WILL MAINTAIN IT, WITH ANNUAL FINANCIAL DOCUMENTATION PROVIDED BY THE TREASURER.
